Your child will need to learn to read a selection of tricky words. They could practice them by playing snap with the words, bingo, or you could even hide them around your home for your child to find and read! Tricky words of the week:
be, you, are, her, was.

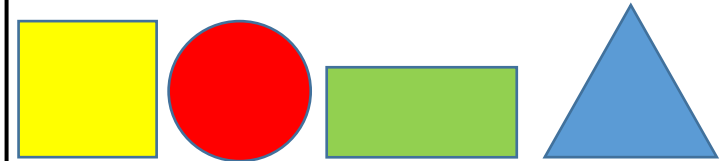


Can you work together to bake a cake?

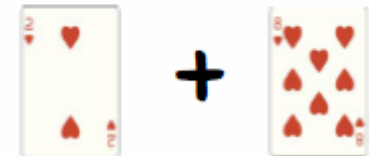
Maths
