Maths

Have a selection of toys. Place the toys into two groups. Ask your child to write a number sentence to find out how many toys we have altogether. E.g. 5 + 4 = .Count all the toys to find the answer.



Where are the jungle animals? To hide the jungle animals around your house for your child to find! Ask your child where they found the animal encouraging them to use positional language e.g. inside, next to, behind, in front, under, on top.
