# THE DAY OF THE INCIDENT

On April 14th 1912 at 11:40pm the RMS struck an iceberg, during the maiden voyage from Southampton England to New York City.

Two hours and 40 minutes later the Titanic sunk to the bottom of the Atlantic ocean. 1496 people died and only 700 people survived that dreadful night.



# Was the Titanic ever found?

The wreck was remained lost at sea until 1985 when oceanographer Robert Ballard discovered it, while on a top secret expedition for the US navy.

The Titanic carried 20 lifeboats but only managed to launch 18 in the time that they had (1 hour and a half).
