Autumn Term 2020 - Year 1/2

Listed below are the areas of learning to be covered next term by your child's class.



In year 1/2, we will be teaching through a creative curriculum in the afternoons. A creative curriculum is one in which students learn through creative and active teaching strategies. A Creative curriculum gets beyond rote learning and focuses on big ideas, interesting projects, and individual students' passions and needs.

English	For our first term we will be refocusing on pencil control, the structure of simple sentences, using our phonics to support with our reading and writing as well as concentrating on our speaking and listening skills.
Maths	In maths this term we will be focusing on working on numbers within 10, including finding 1 more, 1 less, comparing numbers, number bonds and addition and subtraction. To finish the term we will be thinking about 2D and 3D shapes.
Science	Our science focus this term is on the Human body and our senses.
Geography	Looking at our new environments and finding similarities and differences
History	We will be thinking about past and present experiences in our own lives as well as looking at Mary Seacole as part of Black History Month.
Religious Education	What do Christians believe God is like?
PSHE	This term we will be focusing on mindfulness, social skills and relationships.
Physical Education	Gross motor and team skills-football and ball skills - Fine motor skills for pencil control.
Computing	Painting - Using iPads and Apps to create portraits of ourselves and edit them.
