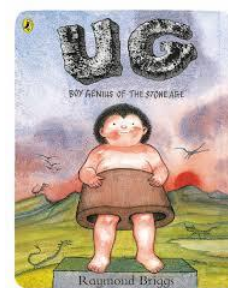
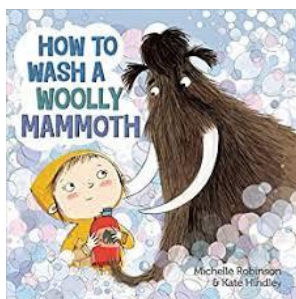

Autumn Term 2020 - Year 3

Listed below are the areas of learning to be covered next term by your child's class.



English	For our first term we will be using texts such as Ug, Cave Baby, How To Wash A woolly Mammoth and Stone Age Boy to help us write recounts, instructions and character descriptions.
Maths	In maths this term we will be focusing on working on numbers within 100, including finding 10 more, 10 less, comparing numbers and addition and subtraction. We will also be looking at numbers up to 1000. To finish the term we will be looking at multiplication and division.
Science	Our science focus this term is on Animals including Humans, thinking about nutrition and diet as well as learning about skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.
History	We will be looking at Early civilizations in Britain and how their lives compared to ours today.
Art	Linking into the Stone Age topic we will be looking at historical artwork using drawing and painting.
Religious Education	In R.E this term, we will be looking at the question 'What is the Trinity?' We will be looking at what the Holy Trinity is and how Christians show their beliefs about God, in worship and the way they live.
PSHE	This term we will be focusing on mindfulness, families and relationships.
Physical Education	For this term our focus will be on team building/problem solving and football.
Computing	Our computing work this term will focus on drawing and desktop publishing.
