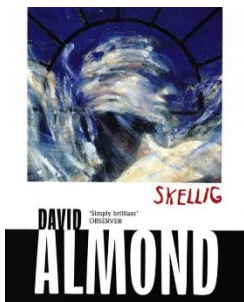

Autumn Term (A) 2021 - Year 5



Listed below are the topics being covered this term by your child’s class. We hope you find the information helpful.

English	Diary entry for Michael who discovers Skellig hiding in his garage. Poetry based on the works of William Blake.
Maths	In this term, we will be looking at place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division using formal written methods and applying our skills into solving problems.
Science	Our first topic looked at the different development stages of humans from fetus to old age. We will move onto life cycles and food webs and finally we will focus on reproduction in humans, animals and plants.
History	Our focus is looking at a history of pandemics, including the Black Death, The Great Plague and more recently the Covid 19 outbreak. We will look at putting the events in chronological order onto a timeline.
Religious Education	To start exploring the gospel of the Good Samaritan and suggest ways in which a bible story may affect Christians today.
PSHE	Examine how their choices will impact on their physical and mental health.
Physical Education	Netball every Monday.

Computing	Image manipulation and using Playground Swift to create algorithms to complete tasks that are more complex.
Design Technology	Children will be researching, designing and creating their own bird feeders.
