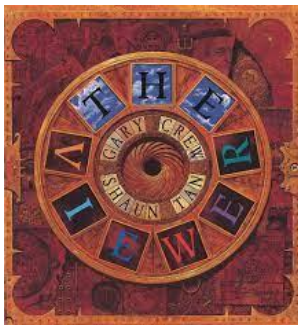

Autumn Term 2021 - Year 6



Listed below are the topics covered this term by your child’s class. We hope you find the information helpful.

English	We have been reading the book <i>The Viewer</i> by Shaun Tan. In English, we have been writing recounts as a diary and also are looking at Free Verse Poetry.
Maths	Solving problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Using estimation to check answers to calculations. Identifying common factors, common multiples and prime numbers.
Science	We have been investigating looking at irreversible and reversible changes. We have conducted an experiment with separating mixtures. We will also be looking at ‘Electricity’.
Art and Design	We have been looking at ‘The Eye’ by Escher, using this as a stimulus we have been working on our shading skills and sketching an eye using the same techniques as the artist.
Religious Education	Understanding Christianity. We are looking at reasons why Christians believe God is worth worshipping and how this can be shown.

PSHE	Internet Safety - We are learning how to take responsibility for ourselves online and understanding how to evaluate sources we find and evaluate the level of risk it poses.
Physical Education	Fitness and Football
Computing	In computing, we are looking at the world wide web and understanding how to navigate around it. To show our skills in this area we have created a PowerPoint with hyperlinks to share with others in class.
MFL	We have started speaking Spanish this term. We are learning how to greet people, ask people what their name is, say our own name and let people know how we are feeling.

Please make sure your child reads at home every day and learns their times tables and weekly spellings, preferably with an adult.
