SENDCo Update

I am pleased to be able to provide an update on our SEND provision here at West Grantham Academy. Our previous SENDCo, Mrs Emma Davison, left us on the 31st October 2021, therefore I prioritised the recruitment of an experienced SENDCo leader in order to continue to provide support, direction and advice for all SEND students, and parents, across both primary and secondary.

I am delighted to inform you of the appointment of our new SENDCo - Mr Kevain Parsons, who will have full oversight and responsibility for all SEND over our three school sites. Mr Parsons commenced the post on the 1st November 2021, and has had a vast and successful career as a SENDCo, Departmental Head, Headteacher, School Improvement Consultant and Assistant Director within both primary and secondary schools, independent specialist schools and PRUs. Mr Parsons is committed and passionate about SEND: three of his four children have SEND, and therefore Mr Parsons understands the challenges being a parent to children with SEND. Mr Parsons will work with the school, on a temporary basis, until a permanent replacement has been found for Mrs Davison. Miss Tamara Weston, our Primary's Assistant SENCo, will be working closely with Mr Parsons and will continue to liaise directly with families as she does now.

Mr Parsons has been trying to meet as many of our SEND students as possible this week and over the next couple of weeks, he will be sending out invitations to all parents/carers of our SEND children to meet him to discuss their child's needs. He understands the difficulty some parents may have in coming into school during the week, so Mr Parsons will be offering either a face-to-face meeting or virtual meeting via Microsoft Teams.
