As scientists we will:

Be exploring light and how it is reflected from surfaces. We will be exploring the light is the absence of light.

As musicians we will:

Identify and describe slow and fast tempos. We be identifying the pulse of the music and exploring AB structure. We will identify note length identifying crochets, minims and semibreves and we will learn and perform the song Reach for the Stars by S Club 7.

In PE we will:

To recognize before and after, dates, and time to the hour.

To measure lengths of objects in centimetres, and to compare lengths and heights of objects. To measure mass and to compare saying if they are heavier or lighter.

In computing we will:

Be exploring pictograms.

We will be exploring how we treat everyone with respect and how we expect respect from those online.

As writers we will:

Be completing writing daily in RWi lessons.

We will be creating an additional chapter with a change of character.

We will be creating a non-chronological report, linked to Isaac Newton.

Key words for this half term are:

Writing: noun, adjective, verbs, sentence, punctuation, characters, poems, prediction.

Maths: Length, height, measurement, mass, weight, volume, cm, non-standard, place value, partitioning.
