We will be describing the characteristics of good friendships and how to use this to develop good friendships.</p>
<p><b>As scientists we will:</b>                  Be identifying the 4 seasons and the weather associated with each one. We will observe different weather patterns and link these to our knowledge of the seasons.</p>	<p><b>In computing we will:</b>                  Be working on spreadsheets and learning how to use these. We will be using 2calculate.</p>	<p><b>As mathematicians we will:</b>                  Be learning about fractions – identifying half, a quarter and a third of a shape and amount. We will recognise the equivalence of a half and two quarters and recognise three-quarters. We will then look at telling the time to O'clock, half past and then to 5 minutes.</p>
<p><b>In RE we will:</b>                  Be learning about different places of worship within Christianity. We will be finding out about special places and why they are special to different people.</p>	<p><b>In DT we will:</b>                  Be creating houses for hedgehogs. We will be looking at different types of materials to create a hedgehog house. We will plan, design, create and evaluate our creations.</p>	<p><b>As geographers we will:</b>                  Be identifying the 4 seasons and the weather associated with each season. We will be learning about hot and cold countries around the world and locating them on the map. We will be comparing the UK to a hot and a cold country.</p>
<p><b>In PE we will:</b>                  Be developing our skills with balls, we will be throwing, catching, and bouncing over nets. We will be learning about net and wall skills.</p>	<p><b>As writers we will:</b>                  Complete a non-chronological report linked to the seasons. We will be retelling parts our novel through a variety of ways as well as attempting to write a new chapter to introduce a character to help the hodgeheg.</p>	<p><b>As readers we will:</b>                  Continue our phonics journey to develop our decoding skills. We will enjoy a range of stories and develop our fluency and comprehension of texts using VIPERS.</p>
