Our key text is:

Rapunzel by Bethan Woollvin



In PSHE we will: be thinking about personal health by considering how we are feeling and behaving and we will develop our understanding of the impact of rest, diet and exercise on our emotional and physical wellbeing.

In computing we will:

Continue to develop our awareness of online safety.

Be able to use technology to begin to create set of simple instructions (algorithms)

As Geographers we will:

Learn the four compass points and use this to use simple maps to navigate to the local park. We will also learn some of the (Ordnance Survey) OS symbols.

As mathematicians we will:

Year 1: know how to sort and count forwards and backwards, recognise numbers as numerals and words, find fewer and more of a number.
We will know how to order and compare numbers and how to use a number line

As mathematicians we will:

Year 2: know how to read a and write numbers to 100, make groups of 10 for counting larger numbers, estimate on a number line and learn to count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.

In RE we will:

We will consider the question, 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?' We will think about how Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus and that advent is a time of preparation.

As Scientists we will:

Identify and describe simple forces of pushes and pulls as well as describe the effects of applying a greater force including the use of magnets.

As artists we will:

Be exploring the work of Pop artist Roy Lichtenstein. We will consider proportion, colour and tone, focussing on Primary colours, drawing 2D shapes and the use of line and pattern within art.

In PE we will:

Develop our gymnastics skills, including jumping, rolling, travelling and balancing. We will use the skills that we learn to create a short sequence and perform it.

As writers we will:

Be developing our writing skills using our phonic knowledge across all areas of the curriculum.
We will explore writing letters and setting description linked to our novel.

As readers we will:

Continue to develop our phonics knowledge and understanding to help us read books fluently.
