



<p>In RE we will: We will consider the question, 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?' We will think about the Easter story and how Christians believe that Jesus rose again giving hope of new life.</p>	<p>As Scientists we will: explore and experiment with sound. We will be creating and participating in experiments and have the opportunity to make our own instruments. We will also begin to identify the features of the different seasons.</p>	<p>As Design Technicians we will: Be making and consuming a Warm Winter Vegetable Salad, following a recipe, learning how to use tools safely for chopping vegetables and discuss improvements that we can make to our dish.</p>
<p>In PE we will: Develop our athletics skills, including jumping, running and throwing. We will refine basic large and small movements and apply these in a range of activities.</p>	<p>As writers we will: Be developing our writing skills using our phonic knowledge across all areas of the curriculum. We will explore writing riddles as retelling the novel The Tin Forest, using lots of our oracy skills to help us to remember it.</p>	<p>As readers we will: Continue to develop our phonics knowledge and understanding to help us read books fluently.</p>
