As early writers we will:

Take part in daily funky fingers activities to improve the strength in our fingers to support our early writing.

We will continue to mark make using different tools and materials, including paint, chalk, and pens.

We will use mark making and early writing skills in our play by making lines and symbols and talk about what our 'words' mean.

We will be recognising words with the same initial sound and have extended conversations about our key texts of the term.

As mathematicians we will:

- -Count and sing number rhymes and action songs every day.
- -Matching, exploring and talking about shapes.
- -Create and continue repeating patterns.
- -Subitise numbers up to 5.
- -Compare and sort collections of objects.

To support our physical development we will:

We will complete small (fine motor) and large (gross motor) physical activities during our choosing time including using one handed tools and equipment and using the climbing apparatus with increasing confidence and ability.

We will begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things. We will talk about the signs of Spring and comment on the changes that we can see.

As artists we will:

Paint and draw on different canvases, using different materials such as pencils, pens, chalk and paint. When painting and drawing we will create closed shapes and use them to represent objects.
