In PSHE we will:

Look at equality with a particular focus on religion. We will recognise that other families sometimes look different to our own and know that we should treat everyone with respect and expect it from others in return.

In computing we will:

Continue to develop our awareness of online safety, particularly cyber-bullying and how to seek help.

Be able to use computers to make music and animation.

As Geographers we will:

Be learning about climate change and analyse patterns over time.
To know which key human contributors change our climate.

In MFL we will:

We will discover the culture of carnival and learn a carnival song.

Revisit colours and numbers and days of the week. We will learn to ask and answer our age

As mathematicians we will:

Year 3: We will be looking at unit and non-unit fractions. Then, we will investigate mass and capacity.

Year 4: Some of us will be doing physical maths with Inspire+ to consolidate our times table knowledge. We will also be looking at decimals.

In RE we will:

Be learning about celebrations and festivals from different religions. We will look at what they represent and how they are done.

As Scientists we will:

Be exploring the topic of Matter. We will be able to compare and group rocks on the basis of their physical properties.
Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.
We will also know how fossils are formed.

As designers we will:

Be exploring what makes a meal healthy. We will be taste testing food and then creating a pasta salad by using the equipment safely to be able to finely chop. We will evaluate our dish to see what improvements can be made.

In PE we will:

Be exploring and learning the skills required to play rounders. Throwing, catching, and running around cones or bases.

As writers we will:

Be developing our writing skills to add to a narrative based on the novel by including a conversation. We will write a poem for World Poetry Day and also write an explanation text about rocks and fossils linked to science.

As readers we will:

Enjoy a range of text types, including poetry and non-fiction books, and develop our fluency and comprehension of texts.
