
Enquiry Question:

Lewis</p>	<p>As writers we will: Continue to develop our skills and vocabulary to engage the readers by producing a wanted poster for the 'White Witch' and creating a fantasy story with an alternative setting.</p> <p>We will also complete a study of the author C.S.
