We gathered to celebrate Mr Thomas' achievements that he has accomplished since joining WGPA!

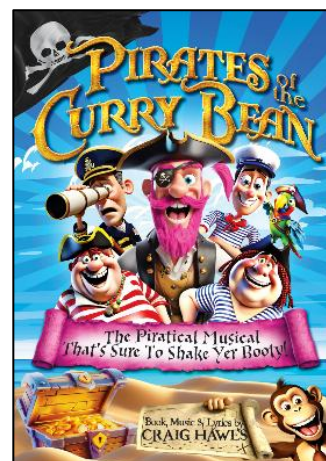
