<p>Our key text is:</p> <p>Where the Wild Things Are</p> 	<p>As mathematicians we will: Year 1 -sort objects, recognise numbers as words, count backwards, find fewer and more. We will also know how to use part-whole models, learn number bonds to 10 and find fact families. Year 2 – read and write numbers to 100, count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. We will learn about adding and subtracting 1s across 10 and add and subtract 2-digit numbers.</p>	<p>As Historians we will: Know about our individual family trees, spanning three generations, and identify key individuals from our own history.</p> <p>In PSHE we will: Describe the characteristics of friendships and use this to develop strong friendships.</p>
<p>In RE we will: Be considering the question” What do Christians believe God is like?” We will explore this question using the creation story and The Parable of The Lost Son</p>	<p>As Design Technicians we will: Be designing and making a boat. We need to make it float on water and be waterproof. We will use appropriate materials and tools and then evaluate our work.</p>	<p>As Scientists we will: Learning about materials and their suitability. We will describe and compare materials and explore their properties to identify materials that are waterproof.</p>
