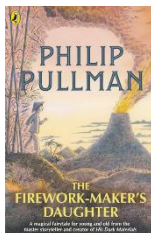


**Enquiry Question:** What makes you scream?

**Home learning project:** Create your own version of ‘The Scream’ by Edvard Munch (Please see next page)

**Our key text is:**

The Firework Maker’s Daughter by Philip Pullman



**In PSHE we will:**

**Key words for this half term are:**

**Writing:** noun, adjective, verbs, adverb, sentence, punctuation, chapter, suffixes, prefixes, diary, poetry, expanded noun phrases, synonyms, fronted adverbials, conjunctions  
**Maths:** addition, subtraction, roman numeral, exchanging, inverse, multiply, divide  
**Topic:** crime, punishment, timeline, history, significance, primary and secondary sources, primary and secondary colours, autumn, fireworks, acrylic, dynamics, space, breathing.

**As Historians we will:**

To look at significant people and events for Crime throughout history for example Guy Fawkes and criminals sent to Australia. We will be able to create a timeline of events and analyse a range of primary and secondary sources

**In MFL we will:**

**Year 3:** Be looking at colours and applying them to our knowledge of Autumn and fireworks. We will learn the days of the week and months of the year.  
**Year 4:** Be looking at classroom commands, recognise places in town and identify names of shops in Spanish.

**As mathematicians we will:**

**Year 3:** Continue our work on addition and subtraction and begin to look at multiplication and division.  
**Year 4:** Measurement – looking at what area is and how to measure it. We will also focus on multiplication and division.

**In RE we will:**

Be learning in more depth about The Holy Trinity. We will be exploring Christian beliefs about the Trinity in more detail and how they show their beliefs in everyday life.

**As Scientists we will:**

Be exploring the topic of ‘Light. We will be able to recognise that light travels in a straight line and explain the effect of the position of an object in relation to a light source on its shadow. We will be able to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.

**As Artists we will:**

Be exploring Edvard Munch’s ‘The Scream’ and use acrylic paints to create our own version.

**In PE we will:**

Be developing our fundamental skills of large and small movements in a range of competitive activities.

**As writers we will:**

Be developing our writing skills to write a shape poem based on fireworks, write a diary entry linked to our curriculum novel and take part in a whole school Christmas write competition.

**As readers we will:**

Enjoy a range of stories and develop our fluency and comprehension of texts.
