As Geographers we will:

be able to locate major countries, explain the human contributions to climate change, including fossil fuel use and deforestation. We will also identify types of tourism and summarise the impact.

In PSHE we will:

Identify our rights and responsibilities.

As musicians we will:

Identify crescendos, diminuendos for the dynamics of music, accelerando and ritardando for tempo and staccato and legato notation on a stave for duration.

In RE we will:
