<p>As year 1 mathematicians we will: be continuing to practise our step counting in 2s. 5s and 10s. We will also understand numbers up to 50 and apply measurement skills of length, height, mass and volume to our provision learning.</p> <p>As year 2 mathematicians we will: continue with our work on multiplication and division, including learning the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and related division facts. We will also be extending our learning on measurement.</p>	<p>Home learning project: Design and make a new container for the Tear Thief to hold the collected tears in. The tears need to be kept separate and remember to consider the properties of materials in your design.</p> 	<p>In computing we will: Continue to develop our awareness of online safety, knowing that people online may not be telling the truth about who they are. We will also use our online learning platform, Purple Mash, to animate stories.</p>
<p>As Geographers we will: Use a map to locate Grantham and consider parts of the town that are less familiar to us. We will recognise some ordinance survey symbols and explore and further understand the four compass points.</p>	<p>Our key text is: The Tear Thief By Carol Ann Duffy</p> 	<p>In PSHE we will: Learn how important family and friendships are in making us feel happy, loved and secure. We will also look at how money and work are linked and understand their importance.</p>
<p>In RE we will: be learning about creation stories from different religious and non-religious beliefs.</p>	<p>As Scientists we will: be considering seasonal change as we move into Spring as well as thinking about how we can protect and look after our world, and the impact of climate change.</p>	<p>As Artists we will: Be using the artwork Mediterranean Landscape by Pablo Picasso to understand more about line and colour. We will recreate a local Grantham scene in a Picasso style, understanding how artists make deliberate choices in order to have an effect on the audience.</p>
<p>In PE we will: Develop our dance skills, thinking about dynamics, space, relationships and performance. We will refine basic large and small movements and apply these in a range of activities.</p>	<p>As writers we will: be writing character descriptions using suffixes to improve our vocabulary, and we will also write a poem about feelings.</p>	<p>As readers we will: Continue to develop our phonics knowledge and understanding to help us read books fluently.
