


Enquiry Question: What makes us happier, giving or taking?

Our key text is:

The Giving Tree



In PSHE we will:

Year 3: Consider different families and their characteristics, learn how to identify, and resolve conflict and identify our own beliefs and how they fit into a diverse society.

Year 4 – Learn about growing and changing.

In computing we will:

Continue to develop our awareness of online safety, particularly cyber-bullying.

Be able to use spreadsheets to collect data.

As Historians we will:

Be learning about Invaders, focussing on the Anglo-Saxon and Viking periods, as well as looking at other invaders using a timeline to sequence events.

In MFL we will:

Year 3: Revisit numbers and dates to talk about our ages and birthdays.

Year 4: Learn how to describe facial features.

As mathematicians we will:

Year 3: Learn how to measure and calculate perimeter, add and subtract with measurements and explore unit and non-unit fractions.

Year 4: We will be learning tenths and hundredths as a fraction and a decimal. We will also learn how to compare, order, add and subtract decimals.

In RE we will:

Be learning about Islam. We will consider how Muslim worship is expressed collectively and ways in which worship and celebration builds a sense of community, considering creation and the natural world.

As Scientists we will:

Be exploring the topic of ‘Life’. We will be able to describe the life cycle and process of reproduction in plants.

As artists we will:

Be exploring ‘study of a Tree’ by Vincent Van Gogh and using line, proportion, and 3D life forms to recreate a sketch of a tree. We will be able to express how art makes us feel and be able to justify our responses.

In PE we will:

We will be visited by Lincolnshire Cricket and shown how to bat, bowl and field to enable us to have a game of cricket.

As writers we will:

Be developing our writing skills to write a narrative based on the novel. We will reverse the story to give to the tree.

As readers we will:

Enjoy a range of text types, including poetry and non-fiction books, and develop our fluency and comprehension of texts.
