



## Year 1/2 Summer Term 2

**Enquiry Question:** Are shortcuts worth it?

<p><b>As year 1 mathematicians we will:</b> Begin to learn about numbers up to 100, including comparing and ordering. We will learn to read an analogue clock to tell the time to the hour and recognise coins and how to count them.</p> <p><b>As year 2 mathematicians we will:</b> Be learning about position and direction, be able to read different graphs and charts and we will be exploring capacity, weight and temperature.</p>	<p><b>Home learning project:</b> Create a picture of a forest and include fairy tale characters or objects that are hidden. How many can you squeeze in?</p>	<p><b>In computing we will:</b> Learn about data handling tools, use yes/no questions to separate information and use a binary tree to answer questions We will then use search tools to learn how to access data bases for information.</p>
<p><b>As Geographers we will:</b> Explore where the Lincolnshire Wolds are on a map and identify three features, including the physical geography of the hills and valleys.</p>	<p><b>Our key text is:</b> Into the Forest by Anthony Browne</p> 	<p><b>In PSHE we will:</b> Be focussing on safety and how to keep ourselves safe online as well as in person. For year 2 children there will be some additional lessons on growing and changing.</p>
<p><b>In RE we will:</b> Continue exploring sacred texts and scriptures, looking at how they are used in worship and different ceremonies within different religions. We will also be able to compare two sacred scriptures.</p>	<p><b>As Scientists we will:</b> Identify what living things need to survive and flourish, investigate how living things change as they grow, and explore the life cycles of animals. We will also recognise and describe how living things differ from non-living things.</p>	<p><b>In art we will:</b> Focus on the work of Henry Rousseau and use different formal elements of art, including texture, tone, colour and pattern to create a collage depicting characters from fairy tales in the style of the focus artist.</p>
<p><b>In PE we will:</b> Be practising our race techniques ahead of Sport's Day as well as focussing on fitness, by considering our agility, balance, coordination, speed, strength and stamina.</p>	<p><b>As writers we will:</b> Research and present information about Anthony Browne, the author of our novel this term. We will also learn the novel and retell it including adding our own twists and characters to the story.</p>	<p><b>As readers we will:</b> Continue to develop our phonics knowledge and understanding to help us read books fluently. We will continue to share, explore and love books at every opportunity.</p>
